Mariners are advised that on the 10th of January 2026, RJ McLeod (Contractors) Limited shall commence works at the RO RO Ferry Berth and the Outer Harbour at Mallaig Harbour.

The work shall include;

- From the 10th of January, dive works will be in the vicinity Steamer Pier and Stub Pier of the Outer Harbour. The programme of work is estimated to last for approx. 2 days.
- From the 12th of January, the deposition of aggregate along the berthing face of the RO RO Ferry Berth from land-based plant. The programme of work is estimated to last for approx. 5 days and will not impact on the scheduled ferry service;
- From the 12th of January, dive works will be in the vicinity of the RO RO Ferry Berth. The programme of work is estimated to last for approx. 5 days and will not impact on the scheduled ferry service.
- From the 15th of January, dive works will be in the vicinity Steamer Pier and Stub Pier of the Outer Harbour. The programme of work is estimated to last for approx. 2 days.

While divers are in the water a flag will be displayed, and the dive supervisor will maintain communication with Mallaig Harbour Master and Works supervisor via VHF Radio throughout the duration of the works.

Pier access by other vessels will be restricted and only permitted by prior arrangement with the Harbour Master.

All vessels navigating in the vicinity of Mallaig Harbour during this time are requested to exercise extra vigilance and pass at minimum safe manoeuvring speed and sufficient distance from the dive works areas so as to minimise the effects of wash.
